Served on the board of the Stanford Financial Group. Was twice President of Switzerland and worked for the UN as a special adviser on sport for peace and development

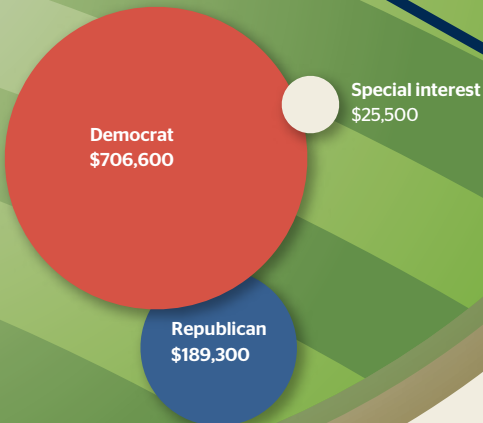
